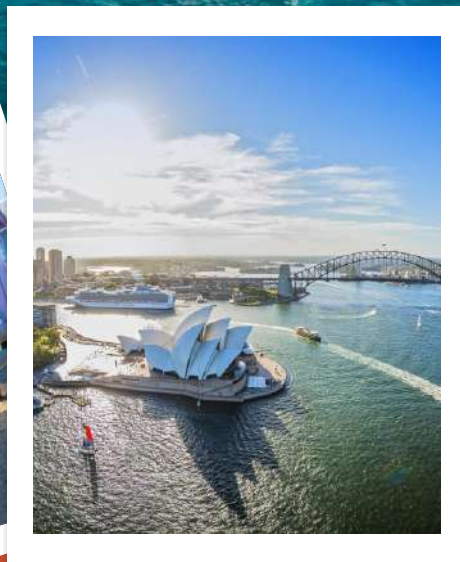

## DAY 1

### Arrival at Melbourne.

Welcome to Australia, the land of Koalas and Kangaroos! On arrival in Melbourne, you will be taken to visit the Melbourne Star Observation Wheel (with Tea / Coffee & cake slice). The Melbourne Star (previously Southern Star) is a giant Ferris wheel in the Waterfront City precinct in the Docklands area of Melbourne, the state capital of Victoria, Australia. Described by its operators as "the Southern Hemisphere's only giant observation wheel", it is 120 m (394 ft) tall and has seven spokes, reflecting the seven-pointed star of the Australian flag. A ride (one complete rotation) takes 30 minutes and, according to the Star's website, provides uninterrupted 360-degree views of up to 40 kilometres (25 mi) "encompassing the Docklands precinct, Melbourne's CBD, Port Phillip Bay and as far as Mount Macedon, Arthur's Seat and the Dandenong Ranges. Later proceed to Hotel | Check into the hotel. (After 1400 hrs). Evening free on leisure

## DAY 2

### Melbourne City tour, Guided tour of MCG & Phillip Island tour

This morning, explore Melbourne on a panoramic city tour. Drive past Bourke Street Mall and the tree-lined beauty of Collins Street - the ultimate shopping strip and business centre. Admire the fine examples of Melbourne's architectural splendour, including St. Paul's Cathedral, Princess and Regent Theatres. Continue to see the Melbourne Town Hall, the Royal Exhibition Buildings and Federation Square. Stroll around Melbourne's spectacular Royal Botanic Gardens. Enjoy 01 hour Guided tour of Melbourne Cricket Ground The Melbourne cricket ground also know simply as "The G" is an Australian sports stadium located in Yarra Park Melbourne, Victoria. The 10th largest stadium globally and the largest cricket ground by capacity. In the afternoon post lunch, proceed to Phillip Island, Cross the bridge at San Remo to enter Phillip Island - natural habitat for koalas, fur seals, Short-tailed shearwater, little penguins and more. Free time at Nobbies this area offers spectacular coastal viewing from the boardwalks and lookout points set amongst natural sea bird gardens. One and a half kilometres offshore from The Nobbies are Seal Rocks, home to Australia's largest Australian Fur Seal colony. Take a moment to learn about the local area from the educational signage and about Australia's Largest Fur Seal Colony at Seal Rocks on Phillip Island. Later proceed to visit Penguin Parade (Viewing Platform) experience one of Australia's most popular attractions. Each night at sunset you'll be amazed by Little Penguins returning ashore after a day's fishing. See the world's smallest penguin in its natural habitat from viewing stands and boardwalks. Enjoy interactive and educational displays in the visitor centre and the spectacular coastal scenery from the Penguin Parade. This experience is sure to be the highlight of your visit. As the sun fades in the sky, Little Penguins waddle up the beach to the safety of their homes in the sand dunes. Witness this magical procession – it is a treat never forgotten. Drive back to city.

## DAY 3

### Avisit Ballarat & Twelve Apostles

Travel to Ballarat and visit Sovereign Hill where you can learn about the history of the Gold Rush and life in the 1850's. Later proceed to Great Ocean Road & Twelve Apostles Tour - See some of Victoria's spectacular coastal scenery and beach resorts along the Great Ocean Road. Port Campbell National Park where we see the amazing 12 Apostles, remnants of London Bridge and the Loch Ard Gorge, the site of many historical shipwrecks.

## DAY 5

### **Today in the morning visit Taronga Zoo**

Taronga Zoo Sydney is a zoo located in the suburb of Mosman, on the shores of Sydney Harbour. Divided into eight zoogeographic regions, the 28-hectare (69-acre) Taronga Zoo Sydney is home to over 4,000 animals of 350 species. It has a zoo shop, a café, and information centre. Afternoon explore Sydney on a panoramic city tour. Travel through the exclusive, trendy suburbs of Neutral Bay admire the spectacular views of Opera House and city skyline from Milsons Point, drive past the Sydney Harbour Bridge, marvel at the Darling Harbour. Visit Bondi beach. Post city tour drop to hotel

## DAY 6

### **Today, you will be transferred to the airport in Sydney, for your flight to Cairns.**

Transfer from airport to hotel in Cairns, en-route enjoy the Kuranda rainforest and Tjapukai Aboriginal cultural park. See the world's oldest living culture brought to life through traditional dance, art and interactive demonstrations. Throw a boomerang and spear, learn about bush food and medicine, didgeridoo playing and more.

## DAY 7

### **Cairns**

This morning, proceed for the ultimate Great Barrier Reef experience – coach will pick you up from your hotel for your transfer to the Reef Fleet Terminal, the departure point of your cruise. Board your Big Cat vessel to commence a full day cruise to Green Island. Big Cat is a modern air-conditioned 35 metre catamaran which takes just over one hour to cruise to Green Island. Enjoy over 5 hours on Green Island with many activities such as a semi-sub coral viewing tour, the choice of a glass bottom boat tour or snorkelling equipment for the day, a fish feeding display, self-guided island walks or simply relax on the white sandy beach. Enjoy lunch on board. Cruise concludes at approximately 5.00pm, at which time hotel drop offs will commence.

## DAY 8

### **Cairns – Brisbane– Gold Coast**

Today, you will be transferred to the airport in Cairns, for your flight to Brisbane. On arrival in Brisbane, you will be transferred to your hotel in Gold Coast. Enroute explore the Brisbane on a panoramic city tour view Parliament house & George square, South bank parkland and Kangaroo Point. Evening is at leisure, you can spend the rest of the time at the beaches, shopping and experiencing the irrepresible energy of the Gold Coast.

Today, enjoy a visit to Sea World, one of Gold Coast's prime attractions. Discover a whole new world of fun and adventure at Sea World, Australia's number one Marine Park! Embark on a journey to save the oceans with the all new Seal Guardians Presentation or chill out in the shade while the kids cool down in Sea World's latest splash pad attraction, The Reef at Castaway Bay. Plus, don't forget to meet Chase and Marshall from PAW Patrol and catch their new show, PAW Patrol On Holiday at the Nickelodeon Stage. Get up close and personal with dolphins, penguins, Polar bears including cub, Mishka and more! If you prefer a thrill, ride our Storm Coaster or Jet Rescue ride. Late afternoon visit Paradise Jet Boat Ride (30 mins). Post tour drop to hotel / Sky Point. Visit Sky point (with Coffee & cake) – No transfers. The SkyPoint Observation Deck is located on level 77 and 78 of the Q1 building. It features a museum, weather station, theatrette and lounge bar across two levels. It is Australia's only beachside observation deck and has room enough for 400 people. It towers 230 metres above the Surfers Paradise beach, giving viewers a 360 degree view of Brisbane to the north, the Gold Coast hinterland to the west, Byron Bay to the south and the Pacific Ocean to the east. The express elevator to the observation deck travels the 77 floors in 43 seconds. Walk back to hotel on own.

### Gold Coast

Morning try something different and take a joy ride on a fire truck with Fire 4 Hire. Travel aboard hotel to the Spit via Surfers Paradise, Narrowneck, Main Beach and Sea World. Drop to Pacific Fair for shopping. Evening drop back to hotel by coach.
